- 5. Ms. Gardner is currently enrolled in an MA-PD plan. However, she wants to disenroll from the MA-PD plan and instead enroll in a Part D only plan and go back to Original Medicare. According to Medicare's enrollment guidelines, when could she do this?
  - Answer: She may make such a change during the Annual Election Peri od that runs from Oct. 15 to December 7, or during the MA Open Enrol lment Period which takes place from January 1- March 31 of each year.
- 6. Mr. Lopez, who is fairly well-off financially, would like to enroll in a Medicare prescription drug plan you represent a nd simply give you a check to cover his premiums for the entire year. What should you t ell him?
  - ~ Answer: He will need to mail in his payment with his enrollment form.
- 7. Mrs. Chou likes a Private Fee-for-Service (PFFS) plan available in her area that does not include drug coverage. She wants to enroll in the plan and enroll in a standalone prescription drug plan. What should you tell her?
  - **Answer:** She could enroll in a PFFS plan and a standalone Medicare prescription drug plan.
