- **A sore that does not heal**
- **Unusual bleeding or discharge**
- **Thickening or lump in breast or elsewhere**
- **Indigestion or difficulty swallowing**
- **Obvious change in wart or mole**
- **Nagging cough or hoarseness**

Phosphorus level

- **3-4.5 mg**

Magnesium levels

- **1.8-2.6 mEq/L**

Chloride levels

- **98-106**

Potassium levels

- **3.5-5**

Sodium levels

Oncological Emergencies
