No vegetables, fresh flowers

High protein foods 5000 calorie diet

Physical therapy

Apply compression dressing after grafts heal

Answer:

Septic Shock

Dissiminated Intravascular Coagulation (DIC)

Answer:

Abnormal coagulation involving fibrinogen

Atalectasis sounds

Answer:

Rhonchi or lack of breath sounds

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Metabolic acidosis

#### <mark>Answer:</mark>

Low pH, low HCO3

Fully compensated metabolic acidosis

#### Answer:

Plasma back to 7.35-7.45

H2CO3/HCO3 ratio back to 1:20

Depressed CO2 levels - hyperventilating

**Depressed HCO3 levels** 

Respiratory acidosis

#### <mark>Answer:</mark>

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A drop in blood pH due to hypoventilation (too little breathing) and a resulting accumulation of Co2.

Mechanical ventilation high pressure alarm

Answer:

excess secretions

kinks

pt biting tubes

coughing

pulmonary edema

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
