Organizing a list of items for the trip

Which thinking skill requires the nurse to collect information in a detailed method from various sources?

Gathering collect and accurate data

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An employee notices a wallet in the restroom with a large amount of cash. Following policy, they take it to the main office. Which thinking skill is the employee demonstrating?

Using legal and ethical and professional guidelines

A parent has been helping their two children with homework and determines that one is improving while the other is still doing poorly. Which thinking skill is the parent using in this situation?

Ask the patient for more information about their lifestyle and routine schedules

Which is an example of subjective data that the nurse might document?

Patient complains of nausea

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Nursing assistant reports patient's urine drainage bag appears to be infected. How will the nurse determine accuracy and reliability of this information?

Contact the physician, request an order for a urine culture

76 yr old from a long-term care facility is admitted with confusion and a large bump on their forehead. What action will the nurse take first?

Conduct a focused neuro assessment

Comparing and contrasting

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A Nurse is caring for elderly patient. The patient states he's been trying to lose weight over the past 3 months but he's gained 15 lbs. What is the nurse's next action?

Conduct a patient interview and research the patient's chart to identify possible reasons for weight gain.

Which step in Tanner's model of clinical judgement involves processing information understanding the situation and planning interventions?

Interpreting

The nurse is assigned to a patient with increased memory loss, confusion and at a high risk of wandering off the unit. What action will the nurse take at the beginning of the shift?

Develop a plan to ensure frequent checks on this patient with the nursing assistants and other staff for safety.

How do the Spices tool and Epworth sleepiness scale assist nurses in caring for older adults?

They both collect signs and symptoms to identify potential risks.

A thinking skill, evaluating data, what is the reason that assessment data is collected again after actions have been performed?

To determine the effectiveness of the actions and see if outcomes were acceptable.
