The salon must retain the most recent WHAT of the autoclave logs? -
ANSWER- The most recent 36 months of the log at the salon for review
by the board.

Sterilized items must be stored in what? - ANSWER- The packaging in
which the were sterilized. Each package must show the batch number
and sterilization date corresponding to the log kept of each sterilization
process.

When do licenses expire? - ANSWER- All licenses expire on the last
day of the individual's birth month of the year due and each licensee is
responsible for applying to renew the license without notice from the
board.

Salon managers renewing license must complete ? CE credits? -
ANSWER- A total of 8 hours of CE credits from board-approved
providers w/in the 3 years prior to the date of license renewal. Licensee
must maintain proof of completion.

4 hours of core CE must consist of? - ANSWER- One hour pertaining to
state cosmetology laws and rules, and 3 hours related to health, safety,
and infection control matters.

How many hours of CE is needed to renew license? - ANSWER- 8 hours total. 4 of CORE and 4 of professional practice.

4 hours of professional practice CE must consist of one or more of the following topics within the licensee's scope of practice - ANSWER- A) Product chemistry and chemical interaction

B) Proper use of machines and instruments

C) Business management, professional ethics, and humane relationships;
OR

D) Techniques relevant to the type of license held by the practitioner.

The CE credits are valid for how long? - ANSWER- They are valid for only one license renewal period.

Can CE credits be applied to multiple licenses held by the same person? - ANSWER- They may be applied to multiple licenses held by the same practitioner if the CEs were completed within the 3 years prior to the license renewal date.

When do salon license expire? - ANSWER- All license expire on the last day of the month of the initial licensure of the year due.

Who is responsible for renewing the salon license? - ANSWER- The salon owner and the DSLM.

Does NOT receiving a notice of renewal from the board constitute as a valid excuse for not renewing SALON license? - ANSWER- **No.**

Who needs to be identified when renewing Salon license? - ANSWER- **The salon must provide the name, current address, and telephone number of the salon owner on renewal application.**

Who else needs to be ID'd on salon renewal app? - ANSWER- **The salon renewal application must identify the current DLSP by name, license #, and license expiration date.**

Professional liability and worker's compensation insurance - ANSWER- **Professional liability insurance coverage of at least \$25,000 for each claim and \$50,000 total coverage for each policy year for each operator.**

What happens when a renewed salon license has not been issued by the expiration date? - ANSWER- **The salon is considered delinquent and is subject to inspection penalties and disciplinary action in MN statues, sec 155A.33, and must cease operations and not resume operations until a salon license has been issued.**

If a completed renewal application is NOT received by the board within 6 months of the license expiration date, what happens? - ANSWER- **The salon is not eligible to renew the license and must apply for a new salon license, meeting all current requirements for salon licensure under part 2105.0310. The salon may not operate until a new license has been issued.**

When do late fees in MN statues, section 155A.25 apply? - ANSWER- When a complete renewal application is received AFTER the license expiration date.

Is a salon that is remodeling or adding additional contiguous space to the current licensed salon required to report such changes to the board? - ANSWER- No, but they must ensure the any changes made are in compliance with this chapter and with applicable building codes and permits processes.

Can a salon license be transferred when a salon moves to a new location? - ANSWER- No. The salon must apply for a new salon license and has 60 days after a move to become licensed. If a new license has not been issued by day 61, the salon must cease operations until a license is issued.

Does a mobile salon that is moving to a new vehicle or new mobile structure need a new mobile salon license? - ANSWER- Yes. They must not operate until a new mobile salon license has been issued.

Change of salon name - ANSWER- The board must reissue the salon license in the new name under the same license cycle after the salon owner ha met the requirement.

Within 60 days of a salon name change, the salon owner must: - ANSWER- A) Submit a salon name change form to the board.
