The RR is 36 breaths/min, O<sub>2</sub> sats is 85% on room air with use of accessory muscles. The nurse places the client on a 4L O<sub>2</sub> nasal cannula. ABGs are: pH: 7.28, PaCO<sub>2</sub>: 50 mmHg, PaO<sub>2</sub>: 75 mmHg, HCO<sub>3</sub>: 26 mEq/L. Which of the following treatments are the nurse's priority

**ANS** Administer bronchodilators

**ANS** Respiratory alkalosis with partial metabolic compensation

5. **Which of the following clients is an example of developing secondary stomatitis**

**ANS** 64 yo client with a history of metastatic breast cancer receiving chemotherapy presenting with stomatitis

6. **The nurse provides discharge instructions to a client recently diagnosed with a hiatal hernia. The client also has a history of GERD. Which should be included in the education**

**ANS** Remain in an upright position for 1-2 hours after eating

7. **Which of the following clients are at risk for developing stomatitis**

**ANS** 55 yo with colon cancer
