-name, date, reason for visit, etc.

Test(s) done to diagnose cholecystitis - ANSWER- abdominal US of RUQ

Test(s) done to diagnose meningitis - ANSWER- LP

Test(s) done to diagnose hemorrhagic CVA - ANSWER- CT Head

LP

Test(s) done to diagnose CHF - ANSWER- CXR

Elevated BNP

Test(s) done to diagnose PE - ANSWER- CTA Chest/ VQ scan
(D-dimer ONLY rules out)

What is it called when you get your kidney removed? -
