5. Relaxed Inhibitions

- **Answer:** - Overly friendly
- Unfriendly, depressed, or quiet
- Become loud
- Make rude comments
- Use foul language

6. Impaired Judgment

- **Answer:** - Complain about drink strength
- Drink faster or switch to larger or stronger drinks
- Make irrational or argumentative statements
- Become careless with money

7. Slow Reaction Time

- **Answer:** - Talk or move slowly
- Unable to concentrate, loses train of thought, forgetful
- Become drowsy
- Become glassy-eye and loses eye contact

8. Impaired Motor coordination

- **Answer:** - Stagger, stumble fall down, bump into objects, sway
- Drop objects, unable to pick up object
- Spill drinks, miss the mouth
