1. 3 types of straight lines used in haircutting

**ANS** horizontal, vertical, diagonal

2. the body's ability to destroy and resist pathogens

**ANS** immunity

3. cape types in barbering

**ANS** shampoo (waterproof) and haircutting

4. Cost for a Class A Barber certificate and renewal

**ANS** \$55

5. How often the Class A barber certificate is renewed

**ANS** every 2 years
